Its main objective is to str engthen the grass root presence of AYUSH systems in the state by showcasing their scientific achievements with documented evidences related to the healthcare challenges. of our contemporary society. Another aim of the Conclave is to address the challenges faced by A YUSH systems, find their solutions through discussions, and create models using inter-disciplinary approach and plan for their effective implementation in the near future. This event is intended to establish Kerala as a global hub of health and wellness services. IAC Kerala will provide a platform for practitioners, scientists, planners, invest ors, indus trialists, s tudents of A YUSH systems and o ther disciplines across the globe to share their views and enrich the future of these vibrant syst ems as a whole. It also provides a unique opportunity for the general public to experience the benefits of AYU SH systems by utilising the opportunities provided through the different events exhibitions, AYUSH Clinics and health food festivals.

# The bi ggest Kerala flood & The role of AYUSH systems in health challenges

The importance and significance of AYUSH systems were ascertained during the days of floods in Kerala. The grass root level presence of these systems acted as a key element in effectively fighting the health menaces due to this calamity and also prevented outbreaks of infectious diseases. The entire AYUSH team enacted wide array of programmes like medical camps for prevention and treatment, rehabilitation activities, house visits & health surveys, prepared medicines locally and supplied it in affected areas etc. The Department also conducted many medical camps for fishermen community, the saviors during flood. Those days also reinstated the importance of interdisciplinary approach and need for creation of more public awareness regarding AYUSH systems and their role in public health.

Kerala is one of the first states in the country to utilize AYUSH systems for effective public health delivery and also the most successful state in general ting an early and effective economic model regarding tourism and wellness industry. Still, more coordinated effects are needed to consolidate its position in the global scenario. The International Conclave is a major step towards this direction.
