* The Govt of Kerala sanctioned the Project of Rapid Action Epidemic Control Cell Homoeopathy (RAECH), Kerala, as per GO(Rt) No.2543/04/H&FWD dtd 07/09/2004. All Epidemic Control Measures are being initiated, monitored and controlled under the supervision of RAECH by distributing preventive medicines, conducting medical camps, health awareness programmes and seminars throughout the State, wherever epidemics break out. Initially the RAECH was structured to meet the Epidemic Control activities but the design can also be utilised even to handle the pandemic situation. Hence the structure of RAECH is sufficient to meet the current Pandemic.

** Target population does not include COVID-19 patients or their contacts or those under quarantine

- DLEG can forward suggestions upon which SLEG can make decisions on the Homeopathic Immune Booster (HIB).
- Homeopathic Immune Booster (HIB) will be supplied free of cost to the target population through government homoeopathic institutions under the supervision of District Medical Officer (Homoeo), District Programme Manager (NAM) and DLEG.
- An efficacy study can be conducted as per the recommendation of Government in a selected district on the Homoeopathic Immunity

Booster Medicine (HIB) for data formulation and analysis as per the norms of ICMR, Department of Homoeopathy, National Homoeopathy Research Institute in Mental Health Govt. of India, and Principal and Controlling Officer.

- The Homoeopathy Department has been implementing many programmes to address various health issues to maintain a better health standard of all strata in the society and to mould a healthy community during the pandemic.

Public can use the peripheral institutions to have primary service of entire specialty units or can also have telephonic consultation. With the limited public transport and other conveyance facilities department focus to give more importance to the Pain & Palliative care and Geriatric care programmes. Districts have already developed mechanism for home delivery of medicines for the needy.
